

# Member Policy

*The following are the member policies for the Residential Wellness Centers. It is expected that all members abide by them or the loss of membership could result.*

- **All members must present their UCARD prior to using the Wellness Center.**
- New members will need to present their UCARD and membership receipt while their UCARD is being programmed. This may take up to two weeks.
- Neither the University nor the Division of Housing and Residence Life/Wellness Program accepts any responsibility for ill health or injury sustained while participating in any of the facilities/programs. No medical or ambulance expense incurred by a participant will be paid by the Division or by the University.
- Participation is on a voluntary basis.
- It is recommended that all participants undergo a physical exam prior to participation and carry some form of health insurance.
- All members must conduct themselves in a mature and responsible manner
- Operational hours may be modified at any time to meet the needs of the student members as well as the staffing. Management will make every attempt to meet the needs of both parties.
- Hours may also be modified if there are inherent dangers due to weather, electricity, or any other situations as determined by the management staff.
- Membership privileges may be revoked for inappropriate behavior, illegal action, dangers to self or others, destruction to property, card access violation, judicial sanctions, and other instances as determined by the Wellness Coordinator.
- Summer Membership refunds will be granted up to **9/18/09**. Regular refunds will be granted within **14 days of purchase**. The original receipt needs to accompany the request.
- Members must have a working UCARD in order to maintain a membership.
- Members are responsible for proper use of equipment. Inspect all equipment prior to usage. Request assistance from staff if unsure how to use equipment.
- All participants must wear proper gym attire. Athletic shoes must be worn. Sandals and open toed shoes are not permitted.
- Rough play, foul language, or inappropriate conduct within the Center is not permitted. The on-duty staff has the permission to dismiss any members as seen necessary.
- The Wellness Center is not responsible for any personal items brought into the facility.
- Personal CD's, tapes, etc. are not permitted to be played on the center radios.
- Headphone use is required for the televisions in some centers.
- Changes on television and radio stations, volume, etc. will be made by the staff member.
- Invalid UCARD numbers, insufficient funds, bounced checks, etc. will result in the immediate loss of membership.
- Personal training by members, non-members, or staff is not permitted. Fitness training is available from staff members, ask a staff member for assistance.
