The Wellness Program was developed in 1988, through the efforts of students and Residence Life staff, for the purpose of creating a safe and healthy space for students committed to maintaining an alcohol and other drug-free lifestyle. The cornerstone of the Wellness Program is the goal of maintaining an alcohol and drug-free lifestyle, while encouraging a holistic approach to living. For a variety of personal reasons, all members of the Wellness Programs choose not to use alcohol and other drugs while they are a member of the Wellness community. This supportive environment brings students, as members of the Wellness Program, together as a community.

____(initial) **To respect my floor member's different motivations for choosing this living option.**

____(initial) **To not possess or consume alcohol or other drugs while on the floor.**

____(initial) **To not return to the floor under the influence of alcohol or other drugs.**

____(initial) **To actively participate in community events including, but not limited to, floor meetings, socials and building wide programs.**

____(initial) **To not have any alcohol or other drug paraphernalia on the floor.**

____(initial) **To have my guests abide by all of the above.**

Residence Life staff may ask students who violate the standard of maintaining the Wellness space as an alcohol and drug-free living environment to re-evaluate their commitment to the Wellness Program. Students who violate the Student Code of Conduct by consuming alcohol while under the legal drinking age, by possessing alcohol in alcohol-free halls/floors or by using and/or possessing controlled substances, may also be referred to the University judicial system, relocated to non-Wellness housing and/or referred to a substance abuse intervention program.
